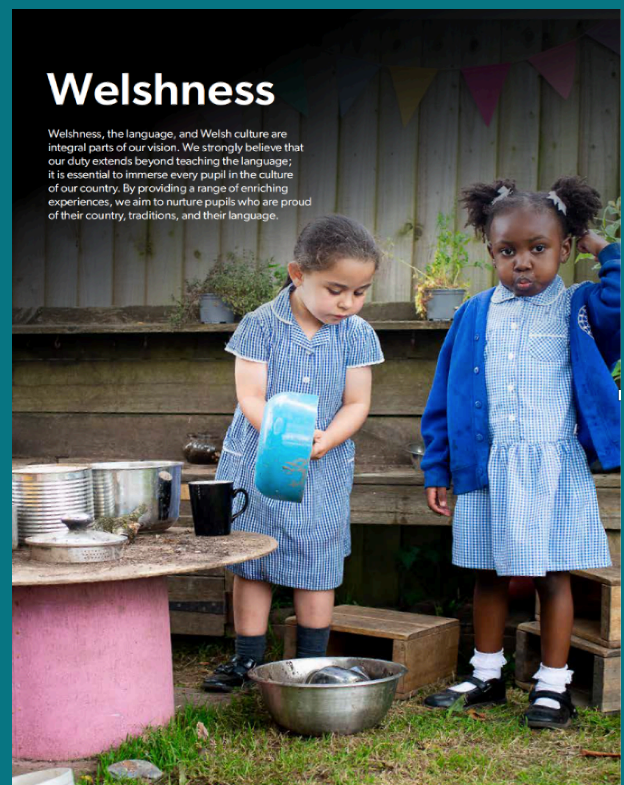
## Family

## Welshness

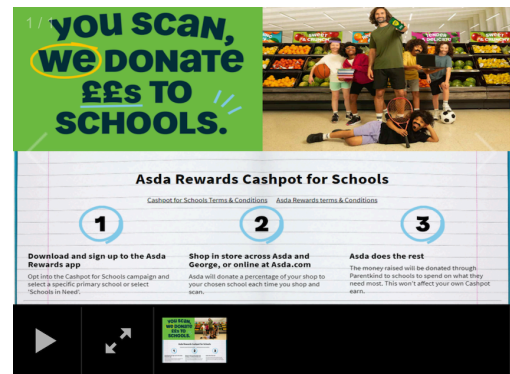
