Parent Workshop (with coffee and cake!).

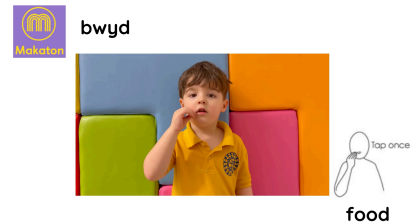
