We kindly ask parents to read and respond to these comments — either by giving a thumbs up or by replying in writing.

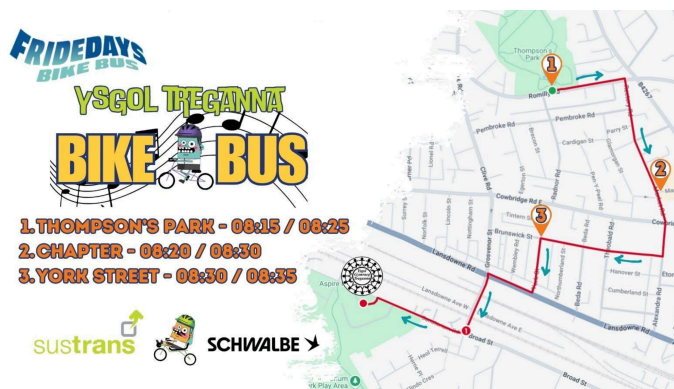
Reading is a priority for us here at Treganna, and we want to ensure that communication between home and school remains positive and constructive.
